Description

This 30-hour compulsory learning module aims to facilitate students to obtain a broadened understanding of public health/preventive medicine theory and practice, as well as their relatedness to laboratorial/ pharmaceutical professionals. The learning is characterized by reviewing most impacting public health issues in Macao during the past decade, and by eliciting active participation and reflection of students.

- 1. Learn the theoretical fundaments of public health/preventive medicine.
- 2. Recognize the history and current situation of public health in Macao.
- 3. Master the roles of Medical personnel in public health management.
