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MODULE DESCRIPTION

The objectives of this clinical placement encompass six core learning abilities, namely, knowledge application, creativity, communication, ethics, team collaboration and holistic care.

- 1. To apply knowledge and skills of community health nursing to clinical practice.
- 2. To demonstrate the ability to plan and to implement health promotion activities to individuals, families, aggregates, and the community.
- 3. To perform community assessment to identify health needs of the community.
- 4. To conduct health education activity to a specific aggregate according to the identified health needs.
