**Description**

This learning module introduces cutting-edge developments in health care. Experts from other health care disciplines are invited to provide students with broad perspectives and most updated information. Broadening of vision is the aim of this module.

**Learning Outcomes**

After completing the learning module, students will be able to:

1. discuss and evaluate updated medical knowledge related to selected specialty areas of medical care.
2. evaluate the roles of nurse specialist in relation to selected areas of specialty nursing practice.
3. critically discuss the nature and key issues of contemporary health care.
4. discuss the importance of keeping abreast of recent development in health care practice, and knowing the practice of fellow members in the health care team.

## **Content**

1. Promoting public health through controlling infections in the community. (3 class hours)
2. Advances in endourology. (3 class hours)
3. Prenatal screening and current downs syndrome ultrasound screening. (3 class hours)
4. Advanced nursing practice in infection control. (3 class hours)
5. Laparoscopic surgery in urology. (3 class hours)
6. Recent development in mental health care. (3 class hours)
7. Patient safety. (6 class hours)
8. Conference. (6 class hours)

## **Teaching Method**

Lectures, videos, case studies, group discussion
