Content

- 1. Promoting public health through controlling infections in the community. (3 class hours)

- 3. Prenatal screening and current downs syndrome ultrasound screening. (3 class hours)
- 4. Advanced nursing practice in infection control. (3 class hours)
- 5. Laparoscopic surgery in urology. (3 class hours)
- 6. Recent development in mental health care. (3 class hours)
- 7. Patient safety. (6 class hours)
- 8. Conference. (6 class hours)

Teaching Method

Lectures, videos, case studies, group discussion
