#### Description

Students learn to understand foreign language texts, use the language correctly and confidently, and understand the foreign culture through foreign language learning. Topics include listening, speaking, reading and writing.

After completing the learning module, students will be able to:

1. tell the time
2. tell the opening hours of a shop
3. describe hobbies
4. describe daily activities
5. talk about the weather
6. ask and give directions
7. buy school items and clothes
8. invite someone to a birthday party and indicate the location of the venue

1. Telling and asking the time - 12 and 24 hour clock - transportation
2. Hobbies - indoor and outdoor activities - frequency
3. Daily routine - reflexive verbs - meals
4. Weather and seasons - activities
5. Asking and giving directions
6. Inviting someone - birthday party
7. Clothes - buying clothes
8. Buying school items
