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MODULE DESCRIPTION

Clinical placement of obstetrical and gynecological nursing includes six core learning abilities. They are namely knowledge application, creativity, communication, ethics, teamwork and acceptance. To define the level standard requirements that each student should meet the MPU grade. Through the internship, students will appreciate the concepts and principles of obstetrical and gynecological nursing and helps them to acquire knowledge and develop attitude and beginning skills in rendering nursing care to normal and high-risk pregnant women during antenatal, natal and postnatal periods in hospital and community settings; develop their skills in managing normal and high-risk neonate, attitude and beginning skills in the management of women with gynecological problems and render pre and post operation care to clients undergoing major and minor disorders. Students are educated to be: team spirited, friendly, orderly, punctual, responsible, tidy, honest etc., and with nursing professional conducts.

Understand the physiological and psychological changes of the puerperal during natural labor and caesarean section in various stages of labor. Correctly state the assessments of the newborn. Correctly name the newborn metabolic screening items. 	40 hours
3	 Pathology Obstetrics and Gynecology ward 1Recognize the structure, functions and operations of the pathology obstetrics and gynecology ward. 2Understand the examination, diagnosis, treatment and nursing of common diseases in the pathology obstetrics and gynecology ward. 3Conduct health assessment and practice nursing procedures skillfully. 4Make the nursing plan, implement nursing procedure, and evaluate the client's response. 5Describe the therapeutic effect, mechanism, and dosage of drugs commonly used in practice, and observe their efficacy and side effects. 6Understand the physical, mental, social changes and behaviors of postpartum cases and their families. 	40 hours

Assignment requirements

Each group of students is required to summarize the knowledge points and issues involved during the clinical internship, and submits them to the school instructor for correction before the end of the clinical internship. The Guidance for Written Assignments should be followed. Either Chinese or English could be used for this assignment. Specific requirements are as follows:

The knowledge points refer to the theoretical knowledge questions asked by the clinical instructors in departments of the obstetrics and gynecology (delivery room, pathology obstetric inpatient department, gynecology inpatient department, postpartum department), and the students discovered themselves which is conducive to consolidating and expanding the knowledge of obstetrics and gynecology nursing during the clinical internship.

- 1. There should have $8 \sim 10$ questions for each department.
- 2. A well-organized answer should be attached to each question.
- 3. References should be attached after the homework to show the source of the answers, organized in the format of the sixth edition of APA.
