MODULE DESCRIPTION

This subject training includes six core learning abilities: knowledge application, creativity, communication, ethics, teamwork, and acceptance. Students will clarify the roles and working routines of nursing. Apply the learned knowledge and skills to practice. Students need to work with other health providers and develop a collaborative working relationship with them. Students are educated to be: friendly, orderly, punctual, responsible, team-spirited, tidy and honest, etc., and subjected to nursing professional conduct.

M3.	Describe the etiology, mechanism, clinical manifestation, treatment, and nursing for medical and surgical diseases.
M4.	Develop and apply the care plan for individual patients.

M6.	Respect medical staff and work effectively as a team member.

Title of Assignment	Nursing Case Study
Words limit (±10%)	2000 words (not including the cover, references list, and appendices)
Due date	The last day of Clinical Placement

Assignment requirements

Before the end of the Clinical Placement, the student selects a client with a specific health problem and conducts the nursing process. The student writes the 'Nursing Care Study' accordingly. The contents should relate to the student's own clinical experience. It should be submitted to the School Teacher. The Guidance for Written Assignments should be followed. Either Chinese or English could be used for this assignment. The marking scheme is as follows:
