MODULE DESCRIPTION

This Guide offers an introduction to the methods for assessment in the subject of Clinical Placement (Mental Health Nursing). Through this practicum, students apply the theoretical knowledge of mental health nursing to clinical practice.

MODULE INTENDED LEARNING OUTCOMES (ILOS)

On completion of this learning module, students will be able to:

M1.	Completion of a PCNSE is mandatory for students prior to commencing their clinical placement.
M2.	Selects a client with a specific health problem and conducts the nursing process. The student writes the 'Nursing Care Study' accordingly. The contents should relate to the student's own clinical experience.
M3.	Sum up the experience and make a reflection. By reflection, the student expresses personal feelings and reviews the effectiveness of integrating theory and practice.

1-3	Recognize the structure, functions and operations of the unit for mental health care services. Conduct health assessment and practice nursing procedures skillfully. Make the nursing care plan, implement nursing procedure, and evaluate the client's response. Describe the therapeutic effect, mechanism, and dosage of drugs commonly used in practice, and observe their efficacy and side effects. Prepare the client for the involuntary admission and discharge correctly; participate in therapeutic activities and special procedure (e.g. MECT) in mental health unit. Conduct patient education, counselling and join therapeutic activities. Report and evaluate client's condition through daily activities.	120
