1. 作業要求 Assignment requirements

每小組於臨床實習單位選擇一位個案(建議可選臨床常見或典型案例),在實習期間透過對該個案的護理照顧過程進行記錄,並遵照下列要求及參考指引,撰寫成臨床個案報告,於臨床實習完結時或之前提交。需 A4 雙面設計,指引如下:

- 1) 應用護理流程 (評估、診斷、計畫、實施和評估) 作為報告框架。 Use the nursing process (assessment, diagnosis, planning, implementation, and evaluation) as the framework for the assignment.
- 2) 結合循證實踐來支持護理計畫和干預措施的意義。 Incorporate evidence-based practice to support the care plan and interventions.
- 2. 作業指引 The following instructions may help to prepare the client care report.
- 1) 護理評估,對個案進行病史收集及必要的身體評估,包括各項主觀及客觀資料。 Conduct a thorough health history and physical examination of the client. Include relevant subjective and objective data.
- 2) 護理診斷,根據護理評估的資料,至少列出兩項個案最相關/最緊急需要處理的護理診斷,並按照 NANDA-I 格式書寫。每項診斷須有相關的評估資料作為實證支持。 Based on the assessment data, identify at least two nursing diagnoses. Use NANDA-I terminology for each diagnosis. Ensure that each diagnosis is directly related to the assessment findings.
- 3) 護理目標,針對每項護理診斷,至少列出一項短期及一項長期可評價的目標,可參考以 SMART 方式書寫。Based on the nursing diagnosis, list out at least one short-term and one long-term nursing objectives. Suggest to apply SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Timebound) approach to write down.
- 4) 護理措施,針對上述護理診斷及護理目標,描述臨床實踐中曾執行的護理措施(至少一項)。 亦可描述護理措施執行過程中遇到的困難及如何應對。Focused on the above nursing diagnosis and objective, describe how the interventions were carried out in the clinical setting. Include any challenges or barriers encountered during implementation and how they were addressed.

- 5) 護理評價,描述個案接受護理措施的成效,以及討論需調整護理計劃的方向。 Evaluate the effectiveness of the care plan and interventions based on the client's response. Discuss any modifications or revisions made to the care plan as a result of the evaluation.
- 6) 個案報告總結,反思個案護理過程的效果,以及將來護理實踐中需要改善的地方。Reflect on the outcomes and suggest improvements for future practice.
