Clinical Assignment

For every group, the students are required to select a client and writes the 'Nursing Case Study' accordingly, including health assessment using Gordon's 11 Functional Health Patterns and nursing records for two days or more using Focus Chart (25% of the final scores). This is a group assignment, and every student should participate in it. In addition to the assessment of the entire assignment, each student's personal performance will also be used as a reference for his or her personal performance assessment.

The written assignment should be submitted by the day before the last day of clinical placement.

Either Chinese or English could be used for the assignments, and the Guidance for Written Assignments should be followed. The marking scheme for the assignment is as follows:
