Description

This 90-hour subject introduces to students' key theories and skills of mental health nursing. They include: 1) the basic principles of specialist mental health care; 2) tertiary prevention work and various mental health care practices. It prepares students to care for the clients with mental illness in both hospital and community settings.

Master the skills in care of adults with mental disorders

Comprehend and master the skill in prevention of substance abuse

Psycho-geriatric cares (3 hours)
