Description

- 2. Describe the major difference between rehabilitation and ordinary treatments.
- 3. Understand the responsibilities and difficulties of rehabilitation nursing.
- 4. Understand the challenges of rehabilitation treatments patients and families facing.
- 5. Assessment the needs of rehabilitation treatments for older adults with chronic health problems.
- 6. Identify the responsibilities of multidiscipline rehabilitation therapists.
- 7. Understand the disabilities and body image disturbances' consequences risky.
- 8. Describe the future and benefits after receiving rehabilitation treatments.
- 9. Students share a client requiring a rehabilitation therapy.
- 10. Share strategies providing to self case with benefits and supportive to the client.

Teaching Method

Lectures, videos, case studies, group discussion.
