Description

The focus of medical literature review is learning to organize information and build up the literature review chapter for thesis. Based on the nursing specialty, students should be able to select relevant search engine, websites and key words to find out suitable references logically. They should also be able to critically read and evaluate the articles and information they found and then summarize the previous research results, point out their advantages and disadvantages, and figure out the research. Finally, write out a literature review chapter that complies with the professional level. The specific contents include: 1). Understand the definition of literature review and the purpose of literature search. 2). Use a search engine or websites related to medical or nursing care. 3). Grasp the inherent logic in selecting appropriate literature and related vocabulary. 4). Learn to critically read and evaluate the documents you obtained. 5). Ability to write a literature review chapter for your research proposal. The process of the module includes teaching through lectures and group discussions. Assessments include planning of literature review, presentation of the literature review, involving the classroom discussion and final version of the literature review chapter of selected topics.

Learning Outcomes

After completing the module, students will be able to:

- 1. Understand definition of the literature review.
- 2. Find out relevant literature for reviewing based on their own topic.
- 3. Summarize the literature critically.
- 4. Present their literature review results.
- 5. Write out a professional literature review chapter for their thesis.

Content

- 1. Definition of literature review
- 2. Why we should conduct a literature review.
- 3. How to conduct a literature review.
- 4. How to critique the research articles.
- 5. How to prepare a literature review chapter.

Class Practice: (15 hours)

Practice Item:

- 1. Prepare a list for key words for searching based on the thesis topics.
- 2. Conduct article searching.
- 3. Discuss the problems for literature obtained.
- 4. Discuss for article critique.
- 5. Present the framework for literature review.
- 6. Present a literature review chapter in group basis.

Teaching Method

Power point presentation by teacher and students and group discussion.

Tasks and responsibilities of student in the Literature Review

- 1. Choose a research topic and agree with your supervisor.
- 2. Make research plan, with help from supervisor if needed.
- 3. Get approval for the research plan from supervisor.
- 4. Prepare the final research plan and use for group discussion.
- 5. Work on review and inform/consult supervisor, as agreed in plan.
- 6. Hand-in draft version of review (either in parts or complete).
- 7. Receive and process feedback on questions and draft material.
- 8. Hand-in the final version of review to supervisor and reader.
- 9. Prepare the final version of review for group discussion.
- 10. Vote and decide the presentation of the review from your group.
- 11. Give presentation for the review.
