Description

This module aims to enable students to analyze relevant concepts and theories and to clarify roles and responsibilities of advanced practice nurses. Through the introduction of concepts and theories as well as the discussion of the development and influencing factors, which are related to advanced nursing practice and research around the world, students are able to retrieve relevant research and write a case study with relevant theoretical knowledge and practical skills, and lay a solid foundation for performing future work and conducting research on advanced nursing practice.

Learning Outcomes

After completing the learning module, students will be able to:

- 1. Analyze relevant concepts and theories of advanced nursing practice.
- 2. Analyze development and influential factors of advanced nursing practice in different countries and regions around the world.
- 3. Clarify roles and responsibilities of advanced practice nurses.
- 4. Retrieval related research in advanced nursing practice.
- 5. Apply relevant theoretical knowledge and researches in writing case study.

Content

- Related concepts and theories of advanced nursing practice (4 hours)
 (ANALYZE: relevant concepts and theories of advanced nursing practice. UTILIZE: relevant concepts and theories of advanced nursing practice.)
- Core Competencies and education preparation of advanced practice nurses (2 hours)
 (DESCRIBE: Core Competencies and education preparation of advanced practice nurses.)
- 5. Retrieval clinical practice and related researches of advanced nursing practice (2 hours) (RETRIEVAL: related researches of advanced nursing practice.)
- 6. Application of related knowledge and researches of advanced nursing practice (6 hours) (GIVE EXAMPLES and APPLY: related knowledge and researches of advanced nursing practice.)

7. Homework preparation (6 hours)

Through literature readings, field trips or interviews, the students will prepare materials for completing two assignments.

8. Conference (6 hours)

All students select a conference/conferences, which is related to advanced nursing practice.

Teaching Method

Lectures, videos, case studies, group discussion, literature readings, field trips or interviews, and conferences are included in this course.
