MODULE DESCRIPTION

This 45-hour course is designed to assist students in mastering and applying leadership skills and quality management strategies. The contents include the key theories/models of nursing leadership and management, roles and competencies of nurse leaders, human resource management, and quality management, current legal & ethical issues in nursing, and the global healthcare system as well as the medical economics and cost. At the end of the course, the students should be able to apply the knowledge and skills they learned to clinical leadership and management.

review

- -Literature review: search strategies, databases
- -Synthesis: related concept clarification, measurements, clinical application, current related studies.
- -Discussion and recommendations

-Conclusion

-References (Citation and reference list must follow APA format)

5) Other requirements:

- -Words: 3,000-3,500 (not more than 4,000)
- -Language: either in Chinese or English
- -Over-due date submissions will be declined (2024-04-18, 23:59)
- -Offense of plagiary will get "0" score even suspension of study
